### **Justice for Benghazi Victims**

Since it began in 1984, the State Department's Rewards for Justice program paid more than \$125 million to over 80 people who provided actionable information that put terrorists behind bars or prevented acts of terrorism. Despite this program's successful track record, no reward is currently offered for the terrorists who attacked the Special Mission Compound in Benghazi in 2012, which led to the death of four Americans.
