Dear Speaker Boehner and Majority Leader McCarthy:


We write to ask for action against President Obama's recent unlawful executive amnesty order. Now is the time for the House to do the will of the people that elected us and fight back against this unconstitutional overreach. Specifically, we believe this lawlessness violates Article II, Section 3 of our Constitution, a provision that demands that the President '...take care that the laws be faithfully executed...' This Article clearly states that Congress makes our laws, not President Obama.

Specifically, we ask that House leadership act on three measures. First, the House should immediately pass a short-term spending bill that defunds the entirety of President Obama's executive order. Second, our body should pass H.Res.757 which would authorize the House to sue the President for any actions in violation of the Constitution in regards to immigration enforcement. Finally, the House must prohibit any funds from being used to provide work permits or green cards to illegal immigrants who are unlawfully living in the United States.

The House has the responsibility to act quickly and decisively to prevent President Obama and his Administration from further deliberate violation of the Constitution. There is too much at risk for this lawlessness to go unchallenged.

In short, we vigorously oppose the President's November 20, 2014 Executive Order and strongly encourage you to act on the aforementioned legislation when the House returns to session the week of December 1st, 2014.




