## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Whereas, on July 20, 2012, an armed gunman opened fire at a movie theater in Aurora, Colorado, killing 12 and wounding 58 others;

Whereas many individuals at the theater selflessly sought to aid and protect others above their own safety;

Whereas the Aurora Police Department and the Aurora Fire Department quickly and bravely acted to prevent the additional loss of life; and

Whereas local, State, and Federal law enforcement, firefighter, and medical service professionals performed their duties with utmost skill and coordination: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring), That Congress—*

3           (1) condemns, in the strongest possible terms,  
4       the heinous atrocities that occurred in Aurora, Colo-  
5       rado;

6           (2) offers its condolences to the families,  
7       friends, and loved ones of those who were killed in  
8       the attack and expresses its hope for the rapid and  
9       complete recovery of the wounded;

10          (3) applauds the hard work and dedication ex-  
11       hibited by the hundreds of local, State, and Federal  
12       officials and the others who offered their support  
13       and assistance; and

1           (4) honors the resilience of the community of  
2           the City of Aurora and the State of Colorado in the  
3           face of such adversity.
