A BILL

To transfer the reversionary interest of the United States between certain land in Flagstaff, Arizona, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST TO**
4 **CERTAIN LAND IN FLAGSTAFF, ARIZONA.**

5 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) CITY.—The term “City” means the city of
7 Flagstaff, Arizona.

1 (2) CITY PARCEL.—The term “City parcel”
2 means the parcel of land conveyed to the City, that
3 is located in the City, south of United States Route
4 66 and north of the relocated Burlington Northern
5 and Santa Fe Railway Company right-of-way, as de-
6 scribed in the deed recorded in Coconino County,
7 Arizona, on October 6, 2014, as document number
8 3703647.

9 (3) RAILROAD PARCEL.—The term “railroad
10 parcel” means the parcel of land conveyed to the
11 Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Railway Com-
12 pany, as described in the deed recorded in Coconino
13 County, Arizona, on June 2, 2006, as document
14 number 3386576.

15 (b) TRANSFER.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—On the request of the own-
17 ers of the City parcel and the railroad parcel, any
18 reversionary interest of the United States pursuant
19 to the Act of July 27, 1866 (14 Stat. 292, chapter
20 278), in and to the City parcel shall be transferred
21 to the railroad parcel.

22 (2) REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION.—The transfer
23 of the reversionary interest under paragraph (1)
24 shall be documented in an instrument that—

1 (A) is suitable for recording in the records
2 of Coconino County, Arizona;

3 (B) is executed by the Burlington North-
4 ern and Santa Fe Railway Company and the
5 City; and

6 (C) references this Act and any prior in-
7 struments relating to the reversionary interest
8 transferred.

9 (3) RELEASE.—On transfer of the reversionary
10 interest under paragraph (1), the City parcel shall
11 no longer be subject to the reversionary interest de-
12 scribed in that paragraph.
