



Your help is greatly needed to stop <u>arbitrary boating restrictions proposed by the U.S.</u> <u>Fish and Wildlife Service</u> on large portions of Lake Havasu.

Government agencies like the Fish and Wildlife Service have continued to enact jobkilling and unlawful regulations that cause severe harm to countless communities throughout the country.

My investigation into the latest proposed boating restrictions uncovered that they are **not based on science or safety**, but rather they are a backdoor attempt to limit recreational boating activities on the lake.

If we do not stand together and fight this continued abuse of bureaucratic power, **unelected and unaccountable government officials will continue to take more control of our lives.**

The economic livelihood of Lake Havasu City depends on the accessibility of the lake for all users. Numerous organizations and individuals have joined me in raised serious concerns and requested a 60-day extension of the comment period including:
