Our organization formed days after the Town of Superior voted to oppose Resolution Copper. We have been successful in gathering continued support for the project, within our leadership the Superior Copper alliance was able to gather over 400 signatures of support for the project, collected signatures to recall Soyla "Kiki" Peralta, and our most recent victory occurred last month when our candidate, Mila Besich Lira won the recall election, by a landslide.
