

RESOLUTION NO. 129-2013

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINKELMAN, GILA AND PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE SOUTHEAST ARIZONA LAND EXCHANGE AND CONSERVATION ACT, AND URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO PROMPTLY ENACT THE BILL AND RECOGNIZING RESOLUTION COPPER COMPANY FOR ITS INVESTMENTS AND EFFORTS TO DEVELOP A NEW COPPER MINE AND ENHANCE THE LOCAL, STATE AND NATIONAL ECONOMIES

WHEREAS, the Town of Winkelman recognizes the significant role that Copper Mining has played in the history of our area and the State of Arizona for more than 100 years; and






