



# CONGRESSMAN PAUL GOSAR CAREER REPORT CARD

## OVERVIEW:

- 11 bills signed into law
- 20 legislative initiatives signed into law
- 79 amendments passed through the House

## CAREER RATINGS:

- Career "A+" grade with the immigration enforcement organization NumbersUSA
- Career 100% rating with the Federation for American Immigration Reform (FAIR)
- Career "A" rating with the NRA and "A+" rating with Gun Owners of America
- Career 100% rating with National Right to Life
- Career "A" rating with the American Conservative Union
- Considered a Taxpayer Hero by Citizens Against Government Waste (96% rating in 2015)



## BILLS SIGNED INTO LAW:

- H.R. 687—Southeast Arizona Land Exchange Act:** (Included in H.R. 3979): Creates 3,700 new jobs, generates \$60 billion for our economy and provides 25% of U.S. copper supply.
- H.R. 1612—The I-11 Intermountain West Corridor Development Act:** (Included in H.R. 22): I-11 and the Intermountain West Corridor will generate \$22 billion for Arizona's economy and creates 240,000 permanent jobs.
- H.R. 4198—Grand Canyon Tourism Jobs Protection Act:** (Included in H.R.4348): Allows 1,721 additional Grand Canyon flights/year utilizing quiet technology. Air tour industry supports 1,250 jobs in Arizona and Nevada.
- H.R. 1345—Catastrophic Wildfire Prevention Act:** (Included in H.R. 2642): Reauthorizes stewardship contracting, Good Neighbor Authority and insect and disease treatment.
- H.R. 4924—Bill Williams River Water Rights Settlement Act:** Provides certainty for the Bagdad Mine which has an annual economic impact of \$339.1 million to the state of Arizona, and sustains nearly 4,000 direct and indirect jobs.
- H.R. 489—C.C. Cragin Dam and Reservoir Act:** Provides a clear approval process for the Salt River Project (SRP) to maintain the Cragin Dam project and allows water to be delivered to Gila County and Phoenix.
- H.R. 3027—Designating the Post Office in Prescott, AZ for Sen. Barry Goldwater:** Conservative stalwart who kicked off his presidential campaign in Prescott, AZ.
- H.R. 1216—Designating the Prescott Vet Center for Dr. Cam McKinley:** A veteran and doctor who spent his life treating veterans with post-traumatic stress disorder.
- H.R. 862—Coconino National Forest Land Conveyance Act:** A Gosar-Kirkpatrick bill. Gosar first introduced H.R. 1038 in the 112th Congress. Provides certainty and right of title for property owners.
- H.R. 4601—Supporting pursuit of new economic development projects within Flagstaff, AZ:** (Included in S.2943) Resolves a title insurance issue and allows for important economic development.
- H.R. 6304—Designating the Post Office in Florence, AZ for Adolfo 'Harpo' Celaya:** A WWII veteran and survivor of USS Indianapolis.

## OTHER MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- Passed House amendment blocking funds for "Sanctuary City" policies
- Blocked new boating restrictions proposal for Lake Havasu and passed House amendment to reopen the lake
- Passed appropriations amendment blocking proposed Grand Canyon Watershed and Sedona Monuments
- Saved the Willow Beach Rainbow Trout Stocking Program preserving 1,700 jobs and \$75 million in economic output
- Passed amendment that resulted in the IRS budget being cut by \$353 million
- Passed amendment blocking Obama's \$500 million raid of Highway Trust Fund, preserving funds for roads and bridges
- Passed House amendment preventing \$440 million from going to terrorist organizations including ISIS
- Passed House amendment that cut \$70 million from EPA Bureaucrats
- Passed two amendments to block Obama's regulation that aims to takeover the local zoning process
- Prevented the Bureau of Land Management from closing its Arizona field office
- Passed provision ensuring veterans receive immediate professional assistance when calling the Veterans Crisis Line
