A BILL

To provide PreCheck to certain severely injured or disabled veterans, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Expedited5 TSA Screening Safe Travel Act" or the "VETS Safe

6 Travel Act".

1SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF PRECHECK PROGRAM TO CER-2TAIN SEVERELY INJURED OR DISABLED VET-3ERANS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 44927 of title 49, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol6 lowing:

7 "(g) AVAILABILITY OF PRECHECK PROGRAM TO
8 CERTAIN SEVERELY INJURED OR DISABLED VET9 ERANS.—

"(1) IN GENERAL.—A veteran described in
paragraph (2) is eligible for security screening under
the PreCheck Program under section 44919 at no
cost to the veteran if the veteran is able to meet the
background check and other security requirements
for participation in the program.

16 "(2) VETERANS DESCRIBED.—A veteran de17 scribed in this paragraph is a veteran who—

18 "(A) is enrolled in the patient enrollment
19 system of the Department of Veterans Affairs
20 established and operated under section 1705 of
21 title 38, United States Code;
22 "(B) has—

23 "(i) lost, or lost use of, a limb;
24 "(ii) become paralyzed or partially
25 paralyzed; or

3 1 "(iii) incurred permanent blindness; 2 and "(C) as a result of a loss, paralyzation or 3 4 partial paralyzation, or blindness described in 5 subparagraph (B), requires the use of a wheel-6 chair, prosthetic limb, or other assistive device 7 to aid with mobility.". 8 (b) COORDINATION ON IMPLEMENTATION.—The Ad-9 ministrator of the Transportation Security Administration and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall jointly-10 11 (1) develop and implement a process under 12 which a veteran described in paragraph (2) of sub-13 section (g) of section 44927 of title 49, United 14 States Code, as added by subsection (a), can receive 15 the benefits under such subsection by not later than 16 one year after the date of enactment of this Act; and 17 (2) provide to Congress a briefing on the status 18 of implementing the process required by paragraph 19 (1) by not later than one year after the date of the

20 enactment of this Act.
21 SEC. 3. OUTREACH FOR DISABLED VETERANS ON AVAIL22 ABILITY OF TRANSPORTATION SECURITY AD23 MINISTRATION PROGRAMS.

(a) COORDINATION.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-fairs and the Administrator of the Transportation Secu-

rity Administration shall develop and implement a process
 under which the Secretary provides to disabled veterans
 effective outreach about Transportation Security Adminis tration programs designed to improve the screening proc ess for passengers with disabilities.

6 (b) FURTHER ENHANCEMENTS TO EASE AIR TRAV-7 EL FOR WOUNDED WARRIORS AND OTHER DISABLED 8 VETERANS.—Notwithstanding section 3501 et seq. of title 9 44, United States Code (commonly referred to as the "Paperwork Reduction Act"), or any other provision of law, 10 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in coordination with the 11 12 Administrator of the Transportation Security Administration. shall— 13

(1) engage appropriate veterans service organizations and other relevant organizations, as appropriate, to assess the awareness of veterans of relevant Transportation Security Administration programs; and

(2) examine the need and feasibility of other
measures to improve travel security procedures for
disabled veterans.

(c) BRIEFING REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 180
days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs and the Administrator of
Transportation Security Administration shall jointly pro-
