1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Criminal Alien Re-
5 moval Clarification Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL GROUNDS FOR DEPORTABILITY.**

2 Section 237(a)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality
3 Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the
4 end the following:

5 “(G) **ADDITIONAL CRIMINAL GROUNDS.**—

6 Any alien who, at any time after admission, has
7 been convicted of a felony or two misdemeanors,
8 whether under State or Federal law, is deport-
9 able.”.
