Re: Relationship with Israel

Dear President Biden:

Rather than criticizing the Prime Minister of Israel, your office should focus on enhancing and protecting the relationship the United States has with Israel. Our relationship is based on mutual respect. Telling a sovereign country how to run its internal matters is not an act of mutual respect.

I trust that the Israelis will not hold it against our nation your inappropriate interference into that nation's affairs. I ask that you reconsider your actions and statements and understand that a mutual friendship among nations means respecting our differences as well as embracing our commonalities.
