**A BILL**

To amend section 230 of the Communications Act of 1934 (commonly referred to as the Communications Decency Act) to stop censorship, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop the Censorship  
5 Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. REVOCATION OF IMMUNITIES.**

7 Section 230(c) of the Communications Act of 1934  
8 (47 U.S.C. 230(c)) is amended—

1           (1) in the heading, by striking “AND SCREEN-  
2           ING OF OFFENSIVE MATERIAL” and inserting “OF  
3           UNLAWFUL OR OBJECTIONABLE MATERIAL”; and

4           (2) in paragraph (2)—

5           (A) in subparagraph (A)—

6           (i) by striking “or otherwise objection-  
7           able” and inserting “, unlawful, or that  
8           promotes violence or terrorism”; and

9           (ii) by striking “; or” and inserting a  
10          semicolon;

11          (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking  
12          “paragraph (1).” and inserting “subparagraph  
13          (A); or”; and

14          (C) by adding at the end the following new  
15          subparagraph:

16          “(C) any action taken to provide users  
17          with the option to restrict access to any other  
18          material, whether or not such material is con-  
19          stitutionally protected.”.
