Stop the Censorship Act of 2020 Sponsored by Paul A. Gosar (AZ-04)

Reforming Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act

This legislation would strike the **red** and insert the **bold**:

(c) PROTECTION FOR "GOOD SAMARITAN" BLOCKING AND SCREENING OF OFFENSIVE MATERIAL OF UNLAWFUL OR OBJECTIONABLE MATERIAL

(1) TREATMENT OF PUBLISHER OR SPEAKER

No provider or user of an interactive computer service shall be treated as the publisher or speaker of any information provided by another information content provider

(2) CIVIL LIABILITY No provider of an interactive computer service shall be held liable on account of—

(A) any action voluntarily taken in good faith to restrict access to or availability of material that the provider or user considers to be obscene, lewd, lascivious, filthy, excessively violent, harassing, or otherwise objectionable, unlawful, or that promotes violence or terrorism, whether or not such material is constitutionally protected,; or;

(B) any action taken to enable or make available to information content providers or others the technical means to restrict access to material described in paragraph (1) (subparagraph (A): or

(C) Any action taken to provide users with the option to restrict access to any other material, whether or not such material is constitutionally protected.
