The status quo in Medicare is a threat to seniors' care

As a Dentist I recently joined my fellow House colleagues who also practice medicine in releasing a list of facts about the broken Medicare system. Some key points include the following:

• The Number Of Workers Paying Into The System Has Declined Over

Time And Will Continue To Decline.

- -Baby boomers started to retire in 2008. This year the oldest of their generation turned 65 and began enrolling in Medicare.
- •Medicare Is Running a Cash Deficit and Has Been For Some Time.
- -The Hospital Insurance Trust Fund has been running a deficit since 2008 and is projected to continue to do so forever. According to a former director of the Congressional Budget Office, in 2011, the Medicare program ran a

\$288.3 billion cash shortfall.

- The Medicare Program Spends a LOT.
- -Under current law and assuming a 10-year 'Doc Fix', net Medicare

spending totals \$2.8 trillion over the next five years, and \$6.6 trillion over

the next 10 years. This is 25 percent of all mandatory spending.

Congress has a moral obligation to adopt common-sense changes to strengthen Medicare and protect seniors. <u>In case you missed it, please see more here.</u>

June 14th: Celebrating Flag Day and the Army's Birthday




"And the star-spangled banner in triumph doth wave O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave!"
