

Based on what I witnessed at the public meeting in Lake Havasu City, the agency should have scrapped this terrible proposal and went back to the drawing board. Instead the Service appears hell-bent on forcing unwarranted boating restrictions down the throats of local stakeholders. ## TAKING ACTION TO STOP BACK DOOR AMNESTY



Open border advocates in Congress will stop at nothing to enact Obama's unconstitutional amnesty...even if that means putting politics ahead of our men and women in uniform.
