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**A BILL**

To require the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives to eliminate its Enterprise Content Management Imaging Repository System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Gun Lists Act of  
5 2022”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT THAT THE BUREAU OF ALCOHOL,**  
2 **TOBACCO, FIREARMS, AND EXPLOSIVES**  
3 **ELIMINATE ITS ENTERPRISE CONTENT MAN-**  
4 **AGEMENT IMAGING REPOSITORY SYSTEM.**

5 The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Ex-  
6 plosives shall immediately eliminate its Enterprise Content  
7 Management Imaging Repository System, and shall not  
8 establish or maintain any system or database which con-  
9 tains information similar to the information in that sys-  
10 tem.

11 **SEC. 3. PRIVATE RIGHT OF ACTION.**

12 A person aggrieved by a violation of section 2 may  
13 bring an action against the United States in any Federal  
14 district court for damages and injunctive relief. The court  
15 shall award a plaintiff prevailing in the action such relief  
16 as the court deems appropriate, including reasonable at-  
17 torneys' fees.

18 **SEC. 4. WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY.**

19 The United States, all agencies and instrumentalities  
20 thereof, and all individuals, firms, corporations, other per-  
21 sons acting for the United States and with the authoriza-  
22 tion and consent of the United States, shall not be im-  
23 mune from suit in Federal or State court by any person,  
24 including any governmental or nongovernmental entity,  
25 for any violation of section 2.
