Subject: Vote NO on H.R. 312: Liz Warren's Casino Bill

Dear Jeff,

House Democrats have placed H.R. 312, Liz Warren's Casino Bill, also known as the Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe Reservation Reaffirmation Act, on the suspension calendar. A vote is expected tomorrow. American Principles Project is urging all Members of Congress to vote NO.

This bill has been pushed by Senator Elizabeth Warren (D-Mass.) and involves several shady organizations that stand to directly benefit from its passage, including the Mashpee Wampanoag Indian Tribe, best known for its controversial involvement with disgraced lobbyist Jack Abramoff in its unrelenting quest to build an Indian Casino, and Genting, a Malaysian gambling conglomerate (currently involved in a major corruption scandal in Malaysia) that has invested more than \$300 million in the proposed Mashpee Wampanoag casino project.

Warren's involvement is especially strange, given her past ideological opposition to casino gambling and her record of voting against gambling expansion — could this be about <u>image rehabilitation</u> after years of embellishing her fake Native American ancestry?
