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1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Environmental Compli-3 ance Cost Transparency Act of 2018".

4 SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY AND REPORTING.

5 (a) INFORMATION INCLUDED IN MONTHLY BILLING TO POWER CUSTOMERS.—The Administrators of each of 6 7 the Bonneville Power Administration, the Western Area Power Administration, the Southwestern Power Adminis-8 9 tration, and the Southeastern Power Administration shall include in monthly billings sent to each of their power cus-10 tomers information estimating and reporting the costs of 11 the customer's share of the direct and indirect costs that 12 13 are incurred by the administration related to compliance with any Federal environmental laws impacting the con-14 servation of fish and wildlife considered by the Adminis-15 trator concerned, at that Administrator's sole discretion 16 after consultation with consumers, to be relevant. 17

(b) DIRECT COSTS.—Direct costs reported under this
section shall include Federal agency obligations related to
costs of studies; capital, operation, maintenance, and replacement costs; and staffing costs.

(c) INDIRECT COSTS.—Indirect costs reported under
this section shall include foregone generation and replacement power costs, including the net costs of any transmission.

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(d) COORDINATION.—The Commissioner of the Bu reau of Reclamation and the head of any other affected
 Federal agency shall assist the Administrators with the
 identification of the costs.

5 (e) REPORT.—No later than January 30 of each 6 year, each of the Administrators referred to in subsection 7 (a), in coordination with the Bureau of Reclamation and 8 other affected Federal agencies, shall provide an annual 9 report to the appropriate committees of the House of Rep-10 resentatives and the Senate that includes—

- (1) estimates of the total direct and indirect
 costs that are incurred by the administration related
 to compliance with any Federal environmental laws
 impacting the conservation of fish and wildlife considered by the Administrator concerned, at that Administrator's sole discretion after consultation with
 consumers, to be relevant; and
- 18 (2) the sources of replacement power.
