Subject: Expenditure Reports Related to the COVID-19 National Emergency Declaration

President Biden,

We write requesting expenditure reports related to the COVID-19 national emergency declaration. As you know, in Article I, Section 9, Clause 7 of the United States Constitution states: “No Money shall be drawn from the Treasury, but in Consequence of Appropriations made by Law; and a regular Statement and Account of the Receipts and Expenditures of all public Money shall be published from time to time.”

Further, 50 U.S.C. § 1641(c) clearly states:

“the President shall transmit to Congress, within ninety days after the end of each six-month period after such declaration, a report on the total expenditures incurred by the United States Government during such six-month period which are directly attributable to the exercise of powers and authorities conferred by such declaration. Not later than ninety days after the termination of each such emergency or war, the President shall transmit a final report on all such expenditures.”

Despite repeated requests, you have not provided *any* of these expenditure reports to Congress related to the COVID-19 national emergency. Please provide all past expenditure reports immediately, as required by law, detailing expenditures incurred related to the COVID-19 national emergency declaration, as well as the final report by July 9th, 2023, as required by 50 U.S.C. § 1641(c).

You recently signed H.J.Res.7 into law terminating the COVID-19 national emergency declaration and it is past time for you to provide required reports to Congress related to COVID-19 national emergency expenditures.




